NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Community Partner,

Thank you for your continued support of the Bermuda Boxing Federation. With your help, our focus is now set firmly towards the Bermuda National Boxing Team qualifying for the 2020 Olympics. Our overall aim is to prepare our adult national team, which comprises of eight persons (three athletes, a team manager, physiotherapist, conditioning coach/cutman, head coach and the technical director/assistant coach) to compete in mandatory boxing qualifier events.

The first mandatory qualifying event for the Olympics is in Mexico between March 9th and 18th 2018. This event will lead towards the Central American and Caribbean (CAC) Games in Barranquilla, Colombia between July 19th and Aug 3rd 2018. We also anticipate the national team to participate in the 2019 Pan American (Pan Am) Games in Lima, Peru.

We have started off this year's local boxing calendar with the event "The NEXT Greatest", which took place on Saturday, February 17th in the Cedarbridge Academy Gymnasium. This event showcased youth and junior class boxing and kickboxing and demonstrated to Bermuda the boxing prowess of our adult national team against seasoned overseas opponents. We are pushing fundraising to support the National Boxing Team, expand our school based youth development programs, and allow us to introduce our Fight for Peace Program.

Our calendar for 2018 is exciting. We will continue to introduce, develop and expand our programs. We also plan to have a combined boxing/ kickboxing/ grappling/ MMA card to kick off the summer. This will be a thrilling event and the first time that MMA will be held in Bermuda. It will be followed by an upscale event at the Fairmont Southampton in November, which has historically been incredibly successful.

As President, I would like to thank your organization in advance for your unwavering support. It is only because of your continued commitment that the BBF will be able to grow and thrive in the future.

ABOUT THE BERMUDA BOXING FEDERATION

The BBF is Bermuda's National Governing Body for the sport of boxing. We are proud of our membership, derived from five (5) main boxing gyms and affiliated combat sports organizations.

The BBF is Bermuda's formal body for the sanctioning of amateur boxing and is tasked with assuring International Boxing Association (AIBA) safety standards and anti-doping regulations are followed. Additionally the BBF:

- Facilitates professional training of athletes, coaches and officials
- Promotes the sport of boxing while increasing participation and supporting member gyms
- Organizes national and international competitions, youth programs and events
- Sets and monitors standards of training, performance and conduct

The Bermuda Boxing Federation aims to encourage participation, promote and develop the sport of boxing in Bermuda by:

- Establishing an Executive Committee to oversee and implement daily duties of the Association;
- Functioning under AIBA rules for boxing in Bermuda;

General Information: Allan "Forty" Rego started training people in the early 1950s and had continued out of his "lions den" home gym right up until his recent passing in February 2018. His legacy will continue on through the work of the countless others he had

influenced and coached throughout the years. The 40 Rego's Gym motto of "Small Gym, Big Knowledge" was truly evidenced through the constant output of champions from its humble Warwick location. Most recently he had worked to groom Andre Lambe and Tyler Christopher, who together are 2/3rds of the Bermuda National Boxing Team as he supported them in their bid to delay turning professional to pursue their Olympic dream. Mr. Rego had become well regarded as the island's most revered trainer and is a quintessential Bermudian Hero. Bermuda Police Gym

Established: 1969

Philosophy: Bridging the gap between the public and the police though fitness. **Founders:** Patrick McBride, Vic Richmond, Willie McCrackin, Authur Wallington

General Information: The Bermuda Police Service have supported a boxing program out of their Prospect Headquarters for close to 50 years. They hold the distinction of being the oldest continuously operating gym in Bermuda. Even though the gym was formally established in the

late 1960s, police boxing had long taken root as an integral part of the Bermuda Police Service's community involvement. There are fight night bills dating as far back as the 1930s featuring local and expat Bermuda Police Officers alike. This legacy continued for many years in that the Bermuda Police Boxing Gym had successfully organized an Annual Police Night of Boxing which included police boxers competing from as far away as Denver, Massachusetts, New York and England. The current generation of athletes are no less skilled or as passionate about the sport as those who came before them.

General Information: Aries Sports Center was opened in July 2017 as Bermuda's first dedicated sports center catering to the whole family. The facility offers group fitness programs and martial arts programs centered around providing quality instruction in the sports of Boxing,

Kickboxing, Jiujitsu and Brazilian Jiujitsu from the age of 3 years old to the general Bermuda public.

The New Controversy Boxing Gym

General Information: Previously based at the end of Mills Creek in Spanish Point, The New Controversy Gym moved into the Queen's Club's basement in December 2012. Head trainer and former heavyweight boxer Leo Richardson has a larger-than-life personality and is the heartbeat of the gym. Coach Leo was given the blessing of Renaud to take over the operation of the gym after months of his training people in Victoria Park caught the attention of the Queens Club members who then rallied behind Coach Leo to offer the gym its new home. With a consistent and impassioned push from Coach Leo, the New Controversy Gym now prides itself in being at the center of the implementation of the island wide Youth Boxing Academy initiative and is regarded as the essential first step for youth who are exploring the art of boxing. The CBG Youth Program was started as a way to reach out to young people and give them a positive avenue. As such, Coach Leo runs many youth focused programs including: after school programs, boxing camps, co-curricular boxing clubs and he is the Vice President of the Bermuda Boxing Federation.

General Information: The Bermuda Sanshou Association is a registered charity (#767) and was created by its standing executive as a vehicle to train and support local martial artists in the discipline of *san shou/san da*. BSA also works to maintain athletes, coaches, and support personnel at a level sufficient to engage in international competition. BSA is a member of International Wushu Federation (IWuf) and its President, Garon Wilkinson is an Executive Board Member of Pan American Wushu Federation, while Vice President Oscar Lightbourne is a Technical Committee member.

PROGRAMS

Youth Boxing Academy

The BBF is extremely proud of our pilot program launched in 2015 entitled "Youth Boxing Academy", which is a 12 week After School Co-Curricular Introduction to boxing based at participating schools. Classes are offered to youth aged 12-18, and take place once a week. The program focuses on attitude, academics, cooperation and community.

We currently have twenty (25) students enrolled in the program and seek to expand over the next several months. The number of schools who have expressed an interest in having this program at present far exceeds our current ability to facilitate it. Our vision for 2020 is to establish an east and western Youth Boxing Academy program which connects with our central academy. Our certified coaches will teach the ARISE program.

Within the ARISE curriculum, students are to learn:

- Team Building
- Leadership
- Resilience
- Anger Management

- Self-Fsteem
- Gang Awareness
- Addiction Prevention
- Gun Resistance

- Violence Prevention
- Health and Nutrition
- Anti-Bullying

Fight For Peace



The Fight For Peace program is the Bermuda Boxing Federation's vision for addressing the number of prevailing social issues which we have seen manifest in our community. Fight For Peace is an internationally recognized and research based program with proven results. This program was initially developed in the favelas of Brasil, and has been successful both in the streets of downtown Kingston, Jamaica and in urban areas of England. It uses boxing and martial arts combined with education and personal development to realise the potential of young people in communities affected by crime and violence. The pillars of the program are Boxing and Martial Arts, Education, Youth Leadership, Employability and Social Support.

Boxing Development Program

The Bermuda Boxing Federation supports the development of children 14 years and under through allocating equipment at no cost, sponsoring children who may come from families without the means to afford monthly training and by hosting youth focused events. Through these events the Boxing Development Program aims to highlight our younger athletes and to encourage both boys and girls to become involved in boxing at an early age.

In expanding our Youth Boxing Academy, Boxing Development Program and to best introduce our Fight for Peace Program, we intend to remove as many barriers from youth participation in boxing as possible. One such barrier is always transportation. With the island's busses often being unreliable and frequently cancelled, the last thing we would want is for a young person or parent to concern themselves with the challenge of getting to and from boxing training. We would like to first consider the safety of our young people in



knowing that they are able to be collected or dropped right to their door. We envision this after school pick-up and drop off service as being an integral part of our successful boxing programs. We also envision being able to transport entire gym classes to any one of our partner gyms for physical education classes.

If you have ever seen our boxing ring setup you can see immediately why this is necessary. Boxing rings are massive. Each piece can be as long as 12 feet in length, weigh 70 plus pounds and there are usually up to 60 pieces that make up one boxing ring. A vast majority of the cost of setting up our boxing ring is trucking. We would desire to eliminate or minimize this expense by purchasing our own truck to haul our equipment island wide. As we aim to establish a boxing academy at each middle and high school in the near future,

monthly competitions in addition to our regular adult and elite schedule, this vehicle will be essential to our long-term growth.

Over the years, the BBF has strengthened its core team who are dedicated to the forward progression of the organization and its affiliates. Supporting the BBF is to simultaneously support boys and girls of Bermuda between the ages of seven (7) and eighteen (18) in pursuing an activity that helps them grow into strong, independent and intelligent adults.
